20/30 GROUP

The 20/30 Group provides a platform for emerging leaders within the Chamber to further develop leadership and entrepreneurial skills, build their circle of influence, contribute to the Coral Gables community, and to have fun! Provides younger professionals of the Chamber with access to a core group of like-minded leaders from which to broaden their network and expand their businesses. They host a monthly networking event, Wind Down Wednesday, the annual Rising Star Awards, and The Chairman's Roast in August.

BUSINESS & EDUCATION | *Meets the fourth Thursday of the month @ 8 AM*

BUSINESS & GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS | *Meets the second Wednesday of the month @ 8 AM*

CHAIRMAN'S AMBASSADORS | *Appointed by the Chairman; Meets the first Thursday of the month @ 8 AM*

Ambassadors assist the Chamber in retaining its current membership through on-going personal contact, participation and education of Chamber member opportunities. Ambassadors also act as table hosts at our monthly Good Morning Coral Gables breakfast.

GLOBAL BUSINESS AFFAIRS | *Meets the first Tuesday of the month @ 9 AM*

Focuses on fostering close relationships with International Businesses, Sister Cities and Consular offices in order to advance awareness of the Coral Gables Chamber of Commerce; works closely with other International Committees of the various organizations in South Florida. Each year they host the Flags on Ponce Program, the International Business Forum and the Gables Global Groove with our Consular Corps.

MEMBERSHIP | *Meets the second Thursday of the month @ 8 AM*

Builds our membership through direct cultivation of new members and supports membership benefits that encourages current members to invite and sponsor prospective members to join the Chamber. Coordinates the monthly Chamber Engagement 101 and the annual Chamber Birthday Blitz outreach event.

WOMEN'S BUSINESS NETWORK | *Meets the first Thursday of the month @ 9 AM*

Meets monthly to organize luncheons featuring informative and engaging speakers that empower women with the latest opportunities for business, self-improvement, and family. Established as a platform to make business contacts. Hosts the annual Businesswomen of the Year Awards in March.

DEI COMMITTEE | *Meets the fourth Tuesday of the month @ 10am*

Meets monthly to discuss diversity, equity, and inclusion goals, initiatives, and partnerships. Seeks out and initiates opportunities to collaborate with other Chamber committees on educational panel discussions, seminars, and discuss best practices and legislation impacting businesses of all sizes.
